## luas info

The Luas is a state of the art light rail transit system that provides an attractive and unique alternative to taxis/buses within the city centre. At Connolly station the Luas will take you to Jervis which is convenient to Temple Bar by crossing the Millennium Bridge. At the other side of Dublin the Luas runs right past the Hilton Hotel, Harcourt Hotel and Camden Court Hotel (2 mins walk) and takes you to the top of Grafton St.



## directions outside city centre

### Clontarf Castle Hotel

The hotel is a 10 min taxi journey from Connolly Station. Alternatively you can travel north on the DART to **Killester** or **Clontarf** stations – the hotel is 10-15 mins walk away.

From the hotel there is a frequent bus service (130) which runs from directly outside the main gates of the hotel and stops just off O'Connell Street.

### Fitzpatrick Castle Hotel

From Connolly Station take the DART to **Dalkey** Station – the hotel is 10 mins walk away.

### The Royal Hotel & Leisure Complex

From Connolly Station take the DART to **Bray** Station – the hotel is 10 mins walk away.

### Royal Marine Hotel

From Connolly Station take the DART to **Dun Laoghaire** Station – the hotel is 10 mins walk away.
