6-day tour



Boppard

Boppard on the Rhine has its own market with a distinct Rhineland flavour. From here we visit Koblenz where the Rhine and Mosel meet and also travel upstream to the magical city of Heidelberg.

Day 1 Thursday We sail from Belfast to Stranraer and continue by coach to Hull for the overnight P&O Cruise ferry crossing to Europoort in Holland.

Overnight: P&O Cruise ferry
(cabins with facilities - all meals included)

Day 2 Friday From Europoort (Rotterdam) we travel to Boppard on the banks of the Rhine, arriving mid-afternoon in time to sample the pre-Christmas atmosphere in the hotel.

Hotel: Ebertor Hotel, Boppard ★★★ (3 nights)

Day 3 Saturday A full day-trip to the wonderful city of Heidelberg, visiting their famous Christmas Market.

Day 4 Sunday We travel down stream today to Koblenz, where the Rhine is joined by the Mosel.

Day 5 Monday After a final morning in Boppard we return to Europoort to catch the overnight sailing back to England.

Day 6 Tuesday From Hull we retrace our outward journey, arriving back at the Europa Buscentre around 10.00pm.

Trier

Trier, the ancient Roman city on the Mosel, has a special market in front of the Cathedral. Hotel Deutscher-Hof enters into the spirit with Christmas trees and hot punch, and we visit the charming smaller towns of Bernkastel-Kues and Cochem, further down stream.

Day 1 Sunday We sail from Belfast to Stranraer and on by coach to Hull for the overnight crossing to Europoort in Holland.

Day 2 Monday From Europoort we travel into the heart of Europe to Germany's oldest city, Trier, on the banks of the Moselle River. St Nicholas treats awaits you (fruit and Christmas sweets) with punch in the hotel lobby before dinner.

Day 3 Tuesday After a lavish buffet breakfast we have a guided tour through this ancient Roman city.

The rest of the day is free to visit the Christmas Market, in the shadow of the Cathedral. Stroll through the many assorted market stalls and pick up a few unique Christmas presents, all with the help of a hot cup of mulled wine!

Day 4 Wednesday This morning we travel downstream to the beautiful towns of Bernkastel-Kues and Cochem. Back in the hotel we have a gala farewell dinner this evening.

Day 5 Thursday We leave Trier this morning and commence our return journey - our home sailing is via Zeebrugge, and we hope to have time for a short stop in the charming city of Brugge en-route.
