**How to get to and from Belfast Grand Central Station by foot**

Opening in September 2024, Belfast Grand Central Station is the largest integrated transport facility in Ireland, providing enhanced local and international connectivity with bus, coach and rail links all under one roof. Inclusive for all, it will be the main terminus station for Belfast. Enhanced integration with the wider public transport network offering connections across Northern Ireland, ROI and beyond, it will offer an enhanced passenger experience for around 20 million bus and rail passenger journeys each year.

Getting to and from the new station is easy, with two main access points via the main Durham Street entrance, and also through the doors on the side of the station beside Grosvenor Road.

The quickest and most convenient way to travel is to pre purchase your tickets through our Translink mLink ticketing app or have your Translink smart card topped up with travel, however you can also purchase a ticket by using our new easy to use ticket vending machines located in the main concourse of the station.

**Wayfinding trails can be found within close proximity of the station, helping you find your way to and from Belfast's new transport facility.**

The wayfinding points will help customers get from Belfast Grand Central Station to Belfast City Hall via the Glengall Street and Grosvenor Road routes, and will also help them find their way back to the station by following the same trail back.

A wayfinding trail will also be in place to help customers to get from Belfast Grand Central Station to Queen's University and Belfast City Hospital via Great Northern Mall and Europa Buscentre, and just like before the same trail can help customers find their way back to the station.
